ABORTION FUNDING IN A POST-ROE WORLD

Each year, NNAF conducts a survey of the more than 90 abortion funds in our network. We collect this data to create a comprehensive picture of what's happening on the ground, as reported by our fund members.

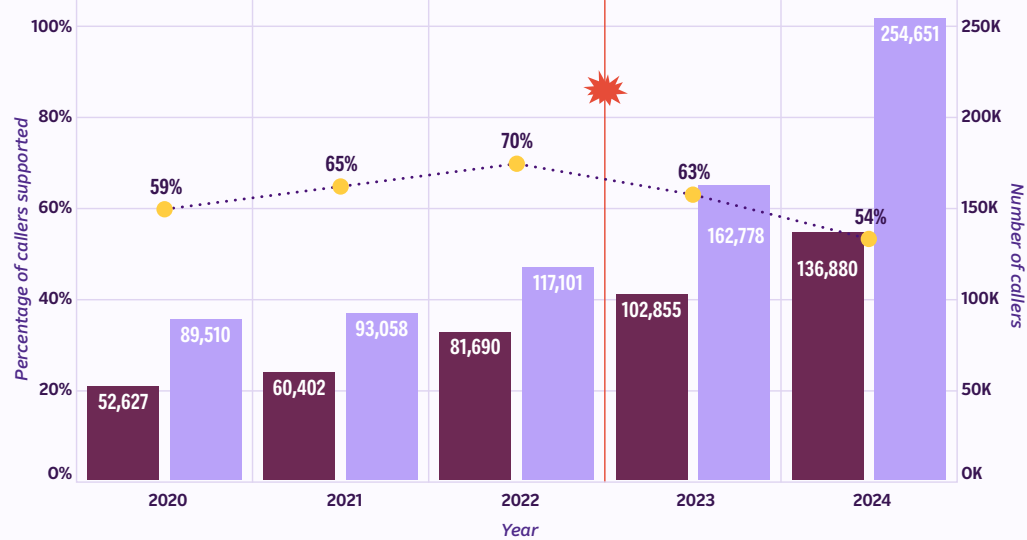
For the first time, we are sharing that report with you, our supporters, so you can see why NNAF needs your help to rapidly and dramatically scale up our grant-making to abortion funds. Abortion funds have the expertise and tools to support callers; what they need from us, bluntly, is more money.

As new threats compound—an FDA review of the medication abortion pill mifepristone, increasing criminalization of abortion seekers, federal cuts to Medicaid, and an overall climate of oppression, surveillance, and punishment—it's all hands on deck to protect abortion access and support our community members.

GROWING REQUESTS OUTPACE SUPPORT

After the *Dobbs* SCOTUS decision in June 2022, funds are stretched thinner than ever, and the need for sustained, increased funding has never been more urgent. As requests surge and logistical challenges grow, funds are struggling to keep pace.

CALLERS: Abortion seekers

REQUESTS: Individual requests for assistance

PRACTICAL SUPPORT: Assistance that is not direct payment for an abortion, such as travel, gas money, lodging, childcare, or translation

FUNDS: Organizations that provide direct support to abortion seekers in their state, region, or community. NNAF is a network of abortion funds.

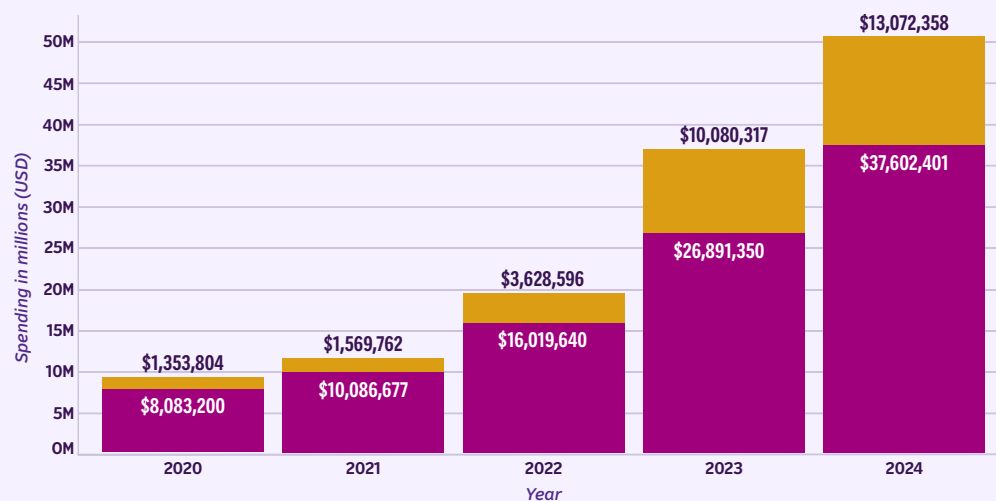

FUNDS ARE SCALING UP, BUT ABORTION IS MORE EXPENSIVE THAN EVER BEFORE

Because of increased travel needs, abortion funding and practical support costs have increased over the past year. As funds navigate abortion bans and harsher restrictions, both abortion procedures and logistical support are more expensive and complicated for funds to sustain.
