

Abortion funds move mountains, but the terrain continues to roughen.

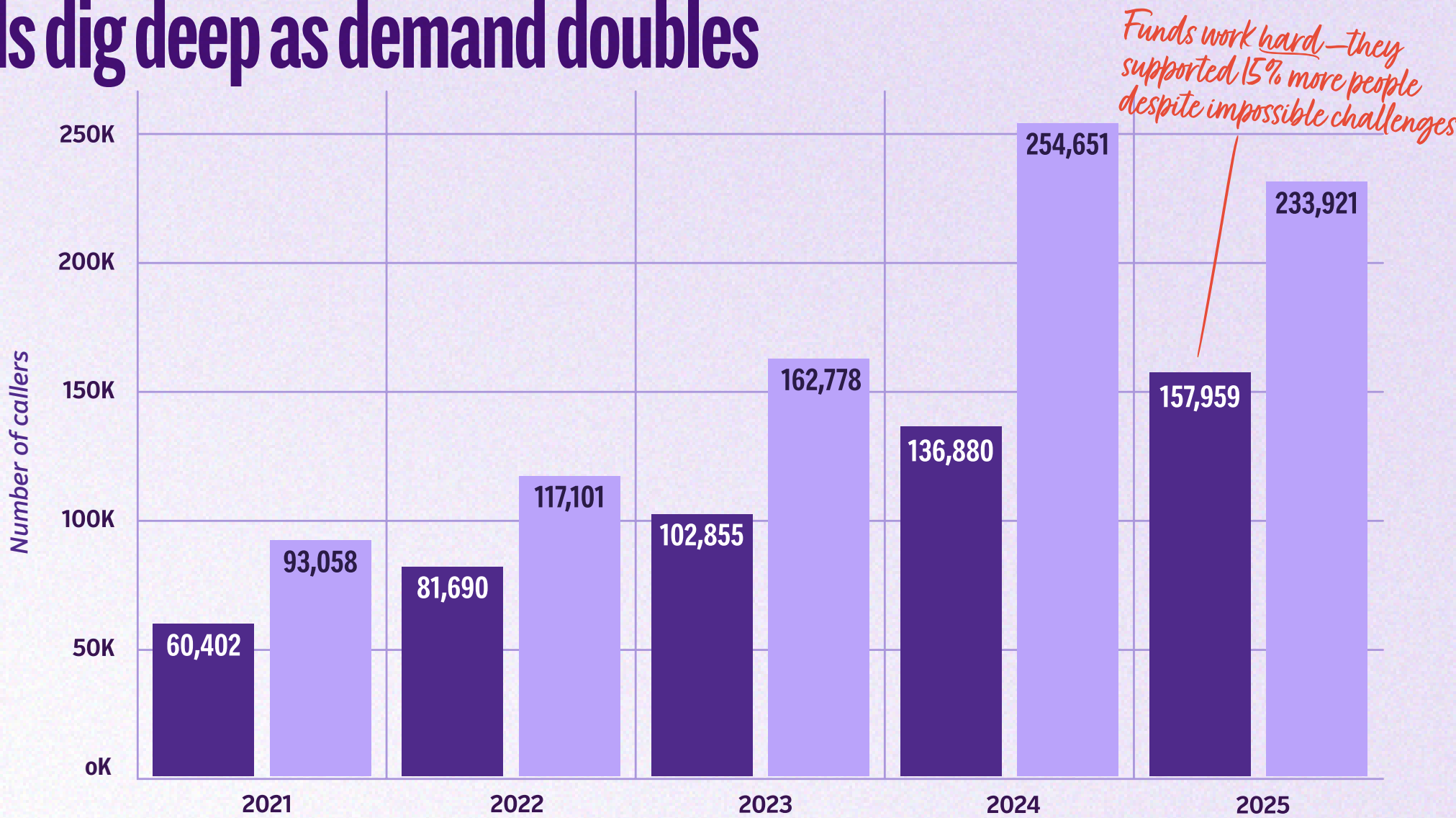
Data shows network's profound impact; skyrocketing cost of abortion access

In the most recent data from abortion funds in this network*, the trend continues: **every year, abortion funds support more callers and spend more on abortions and practical support.** Abortion funds fight hard to close more gaps in abortion access than ever before! But—with increasing costs, obstacles to abortion access piling up, and more people needing

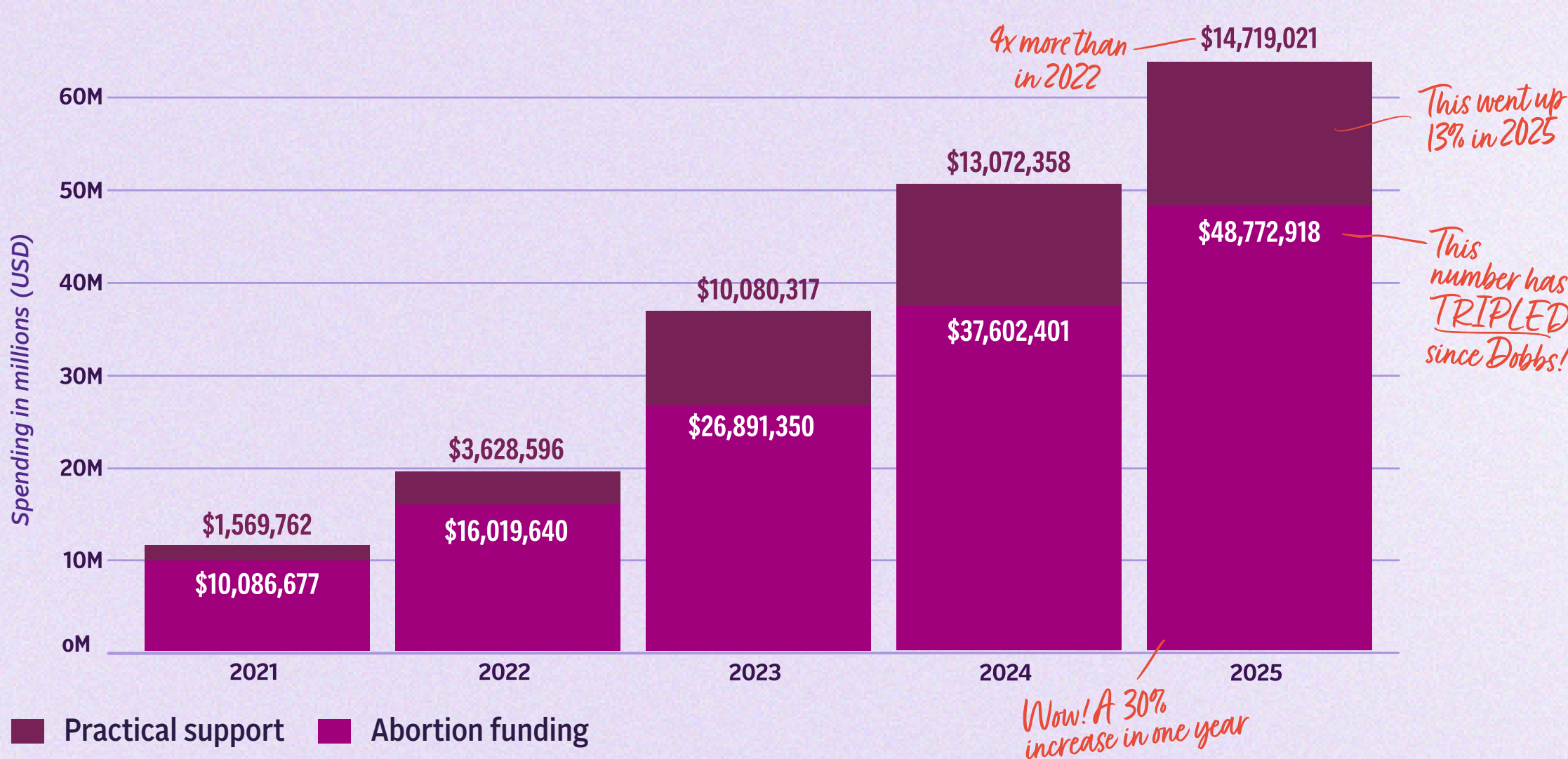
help to get abortions—**funds are stretched impossibly thin, often running out of money quickly.** The message is clear: abortion funds are experts at showing up for their communities no matter what comes their way, and when we invest in them, the impact is tremendous. **And they need our support more than ever.**

Abortion funds dig deep as demand doubles

Since the *Dobbs* ruling in 2022, abortion funds have doubled the number of callers they support, from 82k in 2022 to 158k in 2025. But the need for abortion funding has also doubled since *Dobbs*—from around 117k requests received in 2022 to around 234k in 2025.

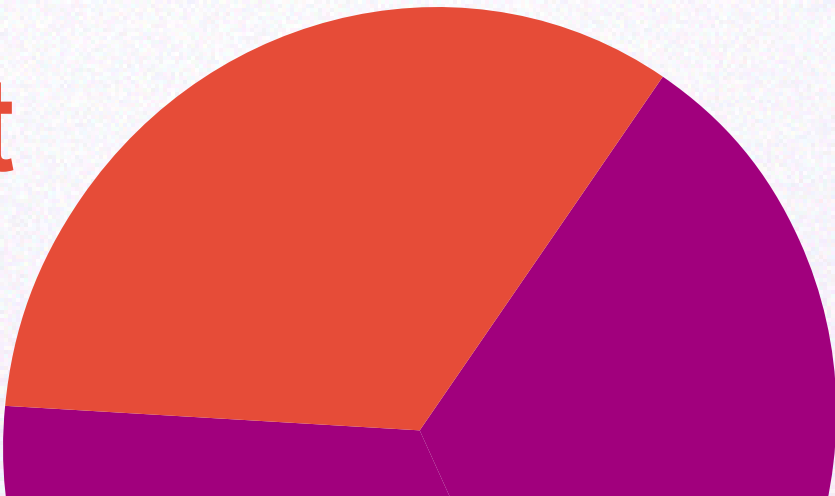


The costs of care and support continue to explode



"Our hotline is closed until next month."

About a third of abortion funds said they had to pause their hotlines and were unable to meet the needs of a large number of callers due to funding, legal issues, staff capacity and burn-out, security concerns, and political crises.

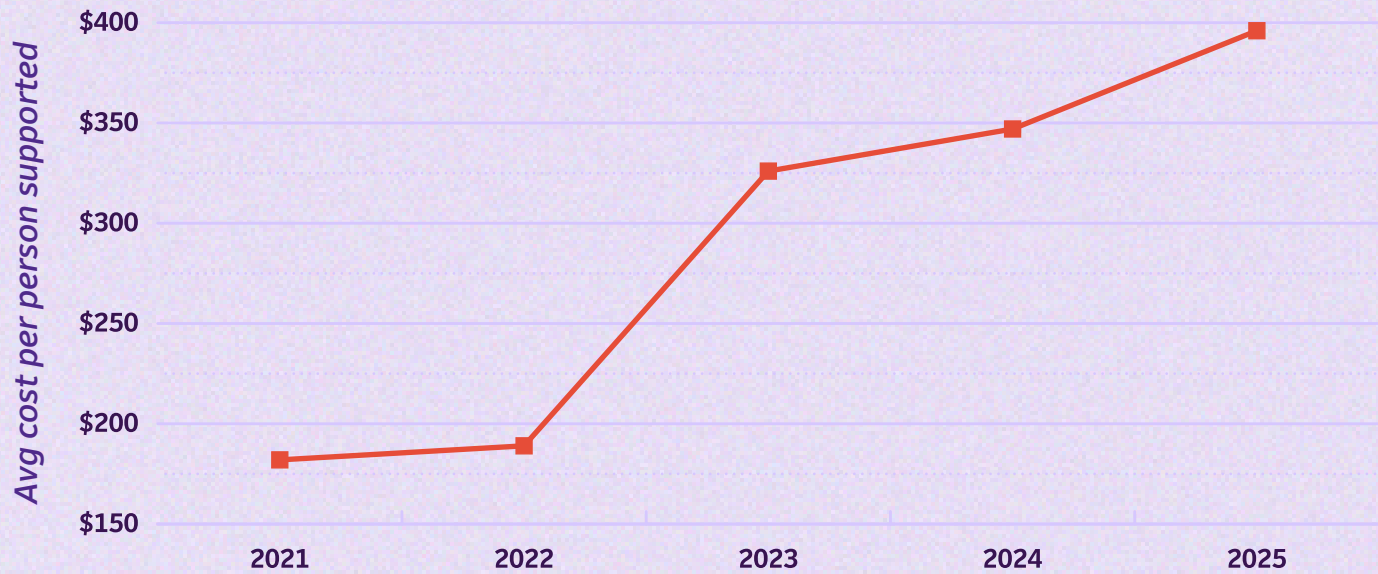


Out-of-state travel is becoming the norm

Only three out of 97 abortion funds reported that none of their callers were traveling across state lines.

43% of funds report coordinating travel across state lines for most of their callers.

Costs per caller have more than doubled



Since *Dobbs*, abortion access has grown so expensive that abortion funds have more than doubled the average dollar amount they've spent supporting each abortion seeker, from pledging less than \$200 in 2022 to nearly \$400 in 2025.

*How this data is collected: Each year, NNAF gathers updates and service delivery changes from member funds in the Membership Engagement Survey (MES). The 2025 MES collected data from July 2024–June 2025, with 97 out of 99 active member funds participating.
